

ADVENTURE EXCURSION IN THE LAND OF THE CARIBOU



With the Adventure Excursion in the Land of the Caribou, the Zoo sauvage de Saint-Félicien offers an original activity in which participants will move from spectators to actors. They will experience an exciting adventure of exploration and discoveries, and full of strong emotions.

Excursion's duration: a day and a half

Schedule: the guide takes charge of the group at 11:00 am (welcoming of participants at 10:30), at the ticket office in the Welcome Center, until the next day at 1:00 pm. Thereafter, participants are free to continue their visit of the Zoo sauvage for the rest of the day.

Summary of the activities: multisensory movie showing, backstage visit of the Zoo (including polar bears' night enclosure), Nature trail Park visit in a private vehicle, vintage lunch at the colonial farm, forest expedition, canoe trip on Lake Montagnais, supper cooked over the fire, evening around the campfire, sleeping in a prospector tent surrounded by a herd of caribou, telemetry basics to find a cow moose, lunch and self-guided tour of the Zoo.

Period of availability: Spring, Summer and Fall (from mid-June to mid-October)

Target audience: all ages (6 and up)

Included:

lunch, snacks, evening meal (3 courses) cooked over an open fire at the camp, breakfast, lunch before the departure, sleeping bag, pillow, towels and all equipment needed for the activities.

Group: minimum 6 persons, maximum 12 persons

Cost per person: \$382.00 (older than 15) – \$345.00 (14 and younger). *Taxes not included.*
